



Port of Los Angeles Operational Update

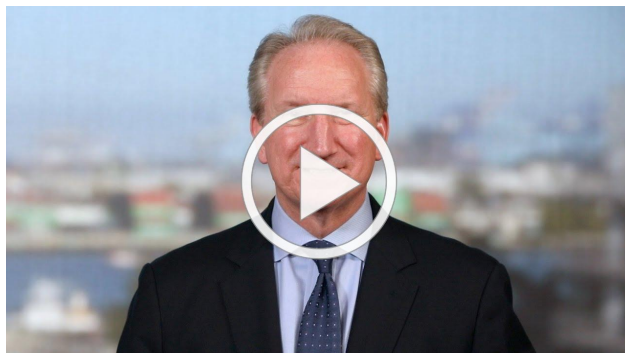
April 6, 2020

The Port of Los Angeles remains open for business and we have not stopped moving cargo.

The Port is moving about 80-85% of our normal cargo traffic volumes as the factories in China and other countries come back on-line after being closed. All of our terminals are open and operational, and labor is continuing to unload cargo and load export cargo.

Today we have 15-ships in Port, 8-container vessels, 3-liquid bulk vessels, 1-dry bulk/general cargo vessels and 2-cruise ships (stocking their stores, no passengers).
